All members of our learning community support and lead each other and themselves to be Successful, Optimistic and Adventurous with their learning while being Respectful to themselves, their environment and their Community.

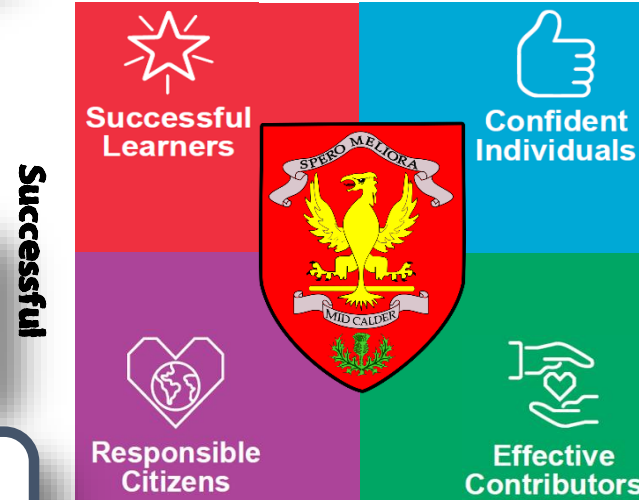


2024/25 Pupil Equity Funding Mid Calder - £16,200
