English and Literacy

Spelling: Weekly spelling words will be issued following a spelling progression with activities that will be differentiated.

Reading: We will be using guided reading sessions to develop and explore key reading skills such as, summarising, predicting, clarifying and questions.

Writing: We will continue to use our PM writing programme and our initial focus will be on information reports

Listening and Talking: In primary 4, the children will be engaging in the Skills Builder programme. The children will engage with listening and speaking skills in the classroom environment.



Numeracy and Maths:

Numeracy: This term our focus will be on multiplication and division.

We will use 'Number Talks' to support the children to develop mental strategies

Maths: This term our beyond number focus will start with time and then measurement.

Digital learning

We are regularly using digital technology within the classroom and logging into 'Microsoft Teams' and other online programmes. If you have any issues with digital logins, please get in touch and I will do my best to sort them.

Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL): Around the world

This term, our IDL focus will be 'Around the world'. This focus has been chosen based of the interests within the class. The class have shown great interest in flags, countries and facts. We will explore different countries through a variety of literacy, geography, health and wellbeing, drama and numeracy activities.

As a class we will discuss what we want to learn and establish key questions, ensuring a child-led approach to our learning.

P.E. Days - Tuesday (outdoor) and Thursday (indoor). Please ensure your child has suitable clothing to change into.

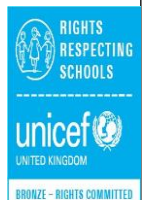
Outdoor Learning - We will have lots of opportunities to learn outdoors, so please ensure your child always has an appropriate jacket.
