English & Literacy	Maths & Numeracy
Phonics: This term, Primary 2 will continue to learn some new digraphs, whilst revising sounds that we have learned this year so far.	This term, pupils will continue building confidence in maths and numeracy. We will focus on strengthening number sense through participating in daily number talks. Through interactive games, group work and outdoor learning opportunities, pupils will gain practical skills that support their problem solving and reasoning abilities.
Reading: We will continue to read four times a week in school, with two books to revise at home each week. This term, we will focus on summarising and clarifying.	
Writing: Our writing focus this term will be recount and descriptive writing. Pupils will continue to learn about sentence structure, grammar and punctuation in weekly lessons.	 Numeracy Addition and subtraction Multiplication Doubling and halving
Listening and Talking: This term, Primary 2 will engage with the Skills Builder programme. The children will engage with listening and speaking skills in our class environment and this will be demonstrated in our class assembly.	Maths Symmetry Data Analysis Chance and Uncertainty
Interdisciplinary Learning: Our Natural World	

This term, our Primary 2 class will be exploring **"Our Natural World,"** an exciting topic chosen by the children themselves, fostering their curiosity about nature, insects, and the environment around them. We will be learning about this context through all curricular areas.

P.E. Days – Monday and Wednesday. Please ensure your child wears clothing suitable for taking part in P.E.

Outdoor Learning - learning in the outdoors will be embedded into our days, so please ensure your child has a sun hat, sun cream etc. every day.

Homework – two reading books will be sent home a week. Additional homework will be included in book bags or posted on Seesaw.

Adults helping in our class:

- Miss Clark will be teaching the children Music this term on Wednesdays. The theme for this will be rhythm.
- Miss Robertson will be teaching the children P.E this term. P.E. may take place on the field so please make sure your child has appropriate clothing for this.
- Mrs Clark and Mrs Agarwal will be our Pupil Support Workers this term.

Reminder – Please try to label coats, jumpers and cardigans. It helps us get them back to the correct children at the end of the day!
