Spelling:

The Phonics International programme will continue to inform our spelling tasks with lots of revisions also.

Writing and Grammar:

Our focus this term will be Recount writing with additional opportunities for free writing weekly.

Reading:

We shall continue with our Guided Reading Literacy Circles as well as PM Reading for Writing to support our reading and writing skills.

Listening and Talking

There will be plenty of opportunities to develop our listening and talking across the curriculum but with a key focus on presenting skills in our Leaver's Assembly and during our literacy circles.

Numeracy and Maths

Numeracy:

We shall continue to solve multi-step problems using the Four Operations with revision of previously taught strategies. We will also focus on working with decimals and rounding.

Maths:

We will revise some of our previous learning with a focus on measurement and data handling. We will look at and interpret a variety of different graphs.

Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL)

As we have a busy and demanding term ahead of us, we will use our upcoming P7 Fair to take on a mini IDL topic - "Enterprise". We have touched on this previously with our EduCake café work but this term pupils will take on a more active role in organising and running their own fundraising stalls. Tuesday and Thursday


Please ensure your child wears suitable clothing on P.E days for indoors/outdoors.
