Maths & Numeracy

Ρ1

We will be exploring number recognition, counting forward and backward, ordering numbers and learning about number bonds to 10 and beyond. We will also develop our number formation skills through regular activities and use songs and stories to help our counting skills development.

In Beyond Number we will look at measure and data handling through our IDL topic 'Minibeasts'.

<u>P2</u>

In P2 we will consolidate our number understanding to 20 and beyond while using concrete materials to support addition and subtraction problems. We will then identify, write, sequence and compare numbers.

We will use our IDL topic 'Minibeasts' to investigate measurement and data handling in more detail, looking at different charts and graphs.

Literacy

Our P1s will begin by developing their phonological awareness by exploring things like rhyme, sound discrimination and syllables. We will also develop our letter and sound recognition, formation and blending skills to support our reading. Stories, songs and actions will be used to develop these.

Reading in Term 1 will be a range of fiction texts, through numerous picture books and stories.

Writing will be developed through black pen drawings and mark making, drawing from the learner's own experiences and imaginations.

Phonics in Term 1 will in include a revision of previous sounds and progressing on to more advanced blending to support their

P2 pupils will develop their **Reading** skills using a wide range of decoding and comprehension strategies while working on fluency and expression.

Writing in Term 1 will focus on Narrative, and we will use Phonics International to support our **Spelling** skills.

This topic will allow us to explore different areas of the curriculum, across both Early and First level to support both our P1s and P2s simultaneously.
