Maths & Numeracy

We will continue developing our addition and subtraction capabilities using concrete materials and pictorials. Pupils will begin exploring estimation using real life examples as well as sequencing, comparing and ordering numbers.

In Beyond Number we will be looking at measurement, investigating and comparing different sizes.

Our focus this term will be on counting on/backwards to 100. We will also continue to develop the learner's addition and subtraction skills while looking at grouping numbers in 10s and 1s. We will also look at estimating quantities and checking by counting, and ordering and comparing numbers to 100.

In beyond number we will investigate measurement in more depth by making estimations and measuring with the appropriate units.



Phonics: We have completed set I sounds and will now use these to blend and make words to ensure the learning is secure before progressing to set 2.

Reading: We will continue to focus exploring texts both fiction and non-fiction. These will also link to our topic. During reading sessions we will make predictions and discuss characters within the story.

Writing: We will continue developing our sentence writing skills through black pen drawings, scribing and looking at descriptive adjectives in more detail.

Listening and Talking: We will continue to practise listening and talking in small groups and whole class discussions. This will help in developing confidence for our upcoming assembly.

Reading: This term we will focus on reading tricky words and introducing the action words programme. During reading we will focus on characters and predictions

Writing: Our writing focus this term will be on Procedure writing where we will look at instructional examples and create our own.

Listening and Talking: We will continue to practise listening and talking in small groups and whole class discussions. This will help in developing confidence for our upcoming assembly.
